NC CAREER LAUNCH

NCBCE has recently received a 4-year grant from the U.S. Department of Labor to kickstart youth pre-apprenticeships throughout North Carolina! A pre-apprenticeship is very similar to a standard apprenticeship, but it allows students to participate in the work-based learning experience while they are still completing their diploma. One of the areas NCBCE is focused on creating pre-apprenticeship opportunities in is technology, meaning Tech Team students can easily transition into a tech pre-apprenticeship if they are ready to take that next step. Some Tech Teams have already taken advantage of this opportunity with their students starting their pre-apprenticeships in the new year!
